90 Youth Summer Job Placements for Aboriginal Youth Ages 15-18

Through the Ontario Government's Summer Jobs for Youth Program, the Waubetek Business Development Corporation is providing summer employment for an **Aboriginal Youth Job Coordinator** to recruit youth and employers for the Summer Jobs for Youth (SJFY) Program. We are seeking an undergraduate University or College level student with excellent communication and organizational skills beginning immediately for the next 17 weeks to co-ordinate and help oversee this program.

Waubetek is also seeking **3 Aboriginal Youth Corps Leaders** who will each be responsible for 30 youth by providing employment coaching to the youth hired by Waubetek in the SJFY program; providing advisory support to these youth during their summer job placements; and assisting in their transitions to future employment and education. The Youth Corps Leaders will help youth to seek placements that match their interests, deliver pre-employment training and monitor on-the-job activity. For these 3 positions, Waubetek is seeking undergraduate University or College level students with excellent communications skills with outgoing personalities who are genuinely interested in helping other youth to succeed in their areas of interest. These 3 positions are available for 8 weeks beginning June 29th and they must have a means to travel to student work placements.

Waubetek is also hiring **90 Aboriginal Youth between the ages of 15 to 18** who will be placed with businesses and organizations in the Manitoulin region. Beginning June 10th, job applications for the 90 youth positions will be available on our website at www.waubetek.com or for pick-up in our office in Birch Island or available at your local First Nation Administration Office. This service through Waubetek is targeted to Aboriginal youth living in the Manitoulin Region.
